On Tuesday, March 15, 2016 the voters of North Carolina passed a \$2 Billion Bond Referendum for infrastructure projects in North Carolina.

The Connect NC bond commits North Carolina to a sound future, investing in our universities and community colleges, agriculture, state parks, National Guard facilities and water and sewer infrastructure. More important is the fact that Engineering firms will benefit directly through projects funded by this Bond, creating new jobs and security for ACEC/NC member firms.

ACEC/NC actively supported the Bond proposal and worked diligently to raise contributions in the effort to educate the public on the benefits of the Bond package.
